

International Student Admission Requirements

Where students Learn What Matters

Applicants are rated on the following criteria:

- Transcripts must be in English and show above-average academic ability
- Students must be responsible, honest, cooperative, demonstrate good character, display character and citizenship, and be respectful of others.
- Students must be self-motivated, responsible for their own success, able to organize their time.
- Applications must be complete and include the main information form, official English transcripts from the last three years, letters of recommendation, and a non-refundable \$100 fee (see application checklist for more details).

Stronger applicants are able to demonstrate proficiency in English. Before being accepted into the program, applicants must meet the English proficiency standards by:

- Submitting results from a standardized English proficiency test such as TOEFL (ALA's TOEFL number is 8777), TOEFL Junior, iTEP SLATE, IELTS, etc.
- Participating in a Skype/internet video interview
- Showing a strong academic history of English coursework

Applicants have a stronger application if they are entering Arizona Lutheran Academy at an earlier grade level and are committed to earning a diploma from Arizona Lutheran Academy. The longer the student is in the program, the greater the success rate of that individual student.
